

## Converting your Diamond Connection Solution data to Truck Tracker 2013

1. If you are using DCS version 4.0.1 or lower then you need to upgrade to DCS version 4.0.2+ first.
  - a. Use this link to install the latest DCS 4 upgrade. [http://fleet-maintenance.com/public\\_downloads/oc\\_updates/DCSCus\\_4.00.5000.exe](http://fleet-maintenance.com/public_downloads/oc_updates/DCSCus_4.00.5000.exe).
  - b. After the upgrade, login to the DCS software again and open the vehicle and parts screens to complete the upgrade of the data files.
  - c. Then close the program and move on to the conversion.
2. If you are already using DCS 4.0.2 or higher then you can run the standalone conversion program.
  - a. Use this link to download the conversion program. [http://fleet-maintenance.com/public\\_downloads/oc\\_updates/DCS\\_Conversion.zip](http://fleet-maintenance.com/public_downloads/oc_updates/DCS_Conversion.zip).
  - b. Run the conversion program from the computer where TruckTracker is installed. If the new software is on a different computer then copy the entire DCSData folder to the new computer first.
  - c. The default DCSData folder is located at C:\DCSData, it can be overridden in the "path.ini" file located in the Diamond Connection Solution program files folder.
  - d. You can run the conversion from any computer as long as you have read access to the DCSData folder and network access to the new SQL Server (TRUCKTRACKER).
